We are Tom & Joanna and we are thankful that you are taking the time to get to know us a bit better!


We have so much love to provide a child and are excited to start our family through adoption. We hope over the next few pages you will see the loving home that we want to provide for a child.



She is sweet, goofy and loves everyone that she meets. Her favorite things are sitting on our back deck with us, chasing her toys, and ear scratches.




